BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the amount of taxes for the 2013 tax levy year extended in the year 2014 for the fiscal year commencing May 1, 2013 and ending April 30, 2014 for the Special Service Area 98-2 to be levied upon all property subject to taxation within the Special Service Area Number 98-2 as established by the City of Calumet City under Ordinance No. 99-16 (legal description attached) is hereby fixed at \$300,000.00 and said sum is hereby accordingly levied upon all property in the Special Service Area 98-2.



**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY,  
ILLINOIS SUPPORTING THE RENEWAL OF A CLASS 6B REAL ESTATE TAX  
ASSESSMENT CLASSIFICATION BY KAY MANUFACTURING COMPANY  
FOR AN INDUSTRIAL AUTOMOTIVE COMPONENTS FACILITY  
(602 STATE STREET)**

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois (the “*City*”) is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the “*Home Rule Powers*”); and

**WHEREAS**, the President and Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook have enacted an ordinance known as the Cook County Real Property Assessment Classification Ordinance, as amended from time to time (the “*Classification Ordinance*”), which provides for a tax assessment incentive classification designed to encourage industrial development throughout Cook County by offering a real estate tax incentive for the development of new industrial facilities, the rehabilitation of existing industrial structures and the utilization of abandoned industrial buildings in order to create employment opportunities and expand the tax base; and

**WHEREAS**, Kay Manufacturing Company, Incorporated (the “*Kay Manufacturing*”) owns a certain parcel of property within the City commonly known as 1602 State Street, Calumet City, Illinois, identified by certain permanent index number (PINs) and hereinafter legally described on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof (the “*Property*”); and

**WHEREAS**, Kay Manufacturing has requested that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City (the “*Corporate Authorities*”) support and consent to the renewal of its Cook County

Class 6B Real Estate Tax Assessment Classification for the Property, as said term is defined in the Classification Ordinance (the “*Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification*”), and as previously authorized by the Corporate Authority, a copy of said authorizing document is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as Exhibit B; and

**WHEREAS**, the adoption of a resolution by the Corporate Authorities is required and must be filed by Kay Manufacturing with its renewal application with the County of Cook in order for the Property to maintain its Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification; and

**WHEREAS**, Kay Manufacturing is an important manufacturer in the City whose economic viability is dependent on the continued Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification; and

**WHEREAS**, to ensure the ongoing viability of the industrial facility, the continuation of numerous employment positions in the City and to safeguard the tax base of the City, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the City to approve the renewal of the Class 6B Real Estate Tax Assessment Classification for the Property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

**Section 1.** The above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

**Section 2.** The Corporate Authorities expressly support and consent to the renewal of the Cook County 6B Tax Assessment Classification for the Property, which is legally described on Exhibit A, and find that without the renewal of the Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification, Kay Manufacturing will not be able to maintain its facility, which will severely hinder development efforts in the area surrounding the Property.



**Section 3.** The Corporate Authorities further find that the granting of the renewal of the Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification is necessary for this industrial development to remain viable on the Property, which is the subject of this Resolution.

**Section 4.** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

**Section 5.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

**Section 6.** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Calumet City (the "City") is an Illinois municipal corporation under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

**WHEREAS**, Kay Manufacturing Company, through its officers, has requested the City Council for the City of Calumet City to support its application for a Cook County Class 6b Tax Assessment Classification for construction to expand an industrial facility located at 602 State Street, Calumet City, Illinois.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Calumet City is a home rule municipality within the purview of Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution (1970), and the City may therefore exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

**WHEREAS**, such City approval is required prior to the filing by the property owner of an application with the County of Cook to be considered for extension of such an assessment classification; and

**WHEREAS**, the County of Cook has adopted ordinances for various real property assessment classifications as an incentive for commercial growth within the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the subject property is located in Thornton Township, which is part of the South Suburban Tax Reactivation Pilot Program; and

**WHEREAS**, in order to promote commercial growth and to promote the creation of new jobs within the City, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City have determined that it is in the best interests of the City to approve the Class 6B assessment classification for the proposed development.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of Calumet City's home rule powers as follows:

**SECTION 1:** The foregoing preambles to this resolution are incorporated herein by reference as though fully set forth herein.

**SECTION 2:** The City of Calumet City finds that extension of the Class 6B incentive program allowed by an ordinance of Cook County, Illinois is necessary for the development that is the subject of this Resolution to occur on the property which is the subject of the Resolution and, therefore, supports and consents to the filing of an application by its officers for the owner of the property in question as provided by said county ordinance for commercial purposes for the property commonly known as 602 State Street, Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois for which the Permanent Index Number is 30-07-201-005-0000 and 20-07-201-007-0000 and legally described as follows:

Eugene S. Pike's Subdivision of part of the Southeast 1/4 and Southwest 1/4 of Section 7, all in Township 36 North, Range 15, East of the Third Principal Meridian, recorded March 2, 1914, as Document Number 5374261, in Cook County, Illinois.

**SECTION 3:** The City supports the requested Class 6b Classification for a term of ten (10) years provided that the Class 6b Classification shall automatically terminate in the

event that Kay Manufacturing Company conveys or otherwise transfers their interest in the said property.

**SECTION 4:** If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not effect any of the other provisions of this resolution.





CLASSIFICATION FOR THE EXPANSION OF A WAREHOUSE  
IN THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, ILLINOIS, COOK COUNTY  
(GATEWAY WAREHOUSE, INC.)**

**WHEREAS**, the officers of Gateway Warehouse, Inc., have requested that the City Council grant approval for a Cook County Class 6B tax assessment classification related to the expansion of a warehouse located at 700 State Street within the City of Calumet City; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Calumet City is a Home Rule municipality within the purview of Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution (1970), and, as such, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and,

**WHEREAS**, such approval is required prior to the filing by the property owner of an application with the County of Cook to be considered for such an assessment classification; and,

**WHEREAS**, a County ordinance allows for various real property assessment classifications as an incentive for manufacturing and distribution growth within the County thereby creating job opportunity and a stable tax base; and,

**WHEREAS**, in order to promote industrial and commercial growth and to promote the creation of new jobs within the City, the City Council of Calumet City has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to approve the Class 6B assessment classification for the proposed new development.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

*Section 1:* That the City Council of the City of Calumet City finds that the Class 6B incentive program allowed by an ordinance of Cook County, Illinois, is necessary for the development to occur on the property which is the subject of the Resolution and, therefore, supports and consents to the filing of an application by Gateway Warehouse, Inc., or by its officers or the owner of the property in question as provided by said county ordinance for the proposed development for manufacturing and distribution purposes for the property hereinafter legally described as:

15 in Cook County, Illinois,

Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, for which the permanent index numbers are as follows:
