

A Special Meeting is being called for Thursday, May 2, 2019 at 6:00 p.m. to be held in the City Council Chambers. The purpose of the meeting is for consideration and possible action on the following:

- 1) Public Comment
- 2) An Ordinance approving a first amendment to an economic incentive agreement by and between the City And Advantage Toyota of River Oaks.
- 3) Approve the purchase of a 2019 Ford F-250 from Currie Motors Frankfort (as part of the Suburban Purchasing Cooperative) in the amount not to exceed \$24,664 for the Animal Control Department; direct the City Treasurer to remit payment to Currie Motors; further to approve the purchase of a Chassis Mount Animal Transport Unit in the amount not to exceed \$14,260.00; direct the City Treasurer to remit payment to Custom Fiberglass Coaches; to be charged to the 2017 Bond Issue.
- 4) 2018-2019 Appropriation Ordinance analysis as of this date.
- 5) Summer Youth Program
- 6) Approve an agreement with Robinson Engineering in the amount of \$33,000.00 for the LED Roadway Lighting Replacement on city owned street lights on Sibley Boulevard and various other locations and pedestrian light installation on Sibley Blvd. payment from the 2017 Bond Fund.
- 7) Collective bargaining
