ROLL CALL OF MEMBERS:

NEW BUSINESS:

Discussion on the validation of the written and oral assessments for Police promotions. Attorney Walsh discussed the reason for the emergency meeting. He explained the error that was made when scoring and generating the report by the company C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. Personnel Testing. He explained, Sgt. Rapaz, Commissioner Cardine, and Commissioner Curry visited the office of C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. to ensure complete transparency and view original testing materials, as well as observe the re-scanning of the written tests.

Sgt. Rapaz discussed what he observed at C.O.P.S. and F.I.R.E. He stated that another error was found with the report and was corrected. He observed the re-scanning of the original written tests through the Scantron machine and reviewed all the original testing materials. Sgt.
