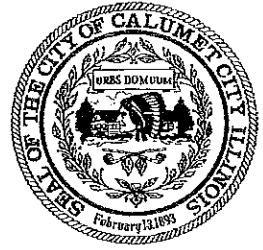


I-CASH PROGRAM

Connecting People With Their Cash/Assets

Dear Residents,

The next 2nd Ward event will be a **I-CASH presentation on Saturday, October 6, 2012 from 12:30pm to 2:30pm at the Calumet City Public Library**. Representatives from the Illinois State Treasurer's Office will be giving a presentation on how they can connect people with their cash and other assets through the I-Cash program. I-Cash was established in 1999 with the goal of helping Illinois residents through the process of reclaiming money and assets. It's common for people to lose track of their assets when they move or when loved ones pass away, and businesses and banks are required to turn over unclaimed accounts to the treasurer's office.

One in eight Illinois residents has an asset to be claimed through I-Cash. The state currently has \$1.5 billion in cash, plus contents from Illinois safe deposit boxes, which need to be returned to Illinois residents.

Some examples of unclaimed property currently held by the treasurer's office include the following:

- **Money from inactive savings and checking accounts**
- **Unpaid wages or commissions**
- **Stocks, bonds and mutual funds**
- **Money orders and bill overpayments**
- **Paid-up life insurance policies**
- **Safe deposit box contents**
