ORDINANCE NO. 14-41

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS
APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN
THE METROPOLITAN WATER RECLAMATION DISTRICT OF GREATER
CHICAGO AND THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY FOR RAINBARRELS**

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois (the "*City*") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "*Home Rule Powers*"); and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 10 of the Illinois Constitution of 1970 authorizes units of local government to enter into contract to exercise, combine or transfer any power or function not prohibited by law; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Cooperation Act, 5 ILCS 220/1 *et seq.*, (the "*Act*") authorizes units of local government to exercise jointly with any public agency of the State, including other units of local government, any power, privilege or authority which may be exercised by a unit of local government individually, and to enter into contracts for the performance of governmental services, activities or undertakings; and

WHEREAS, the Metropolitan Water Reclamation District of Greater Chicago (the "*District*") is a duly organized municipal corporation, organized and existing under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City (the "*Corporate Authorities*") to enter into an Intergovernmental Agreement by and between the

District and the City providing for the distribution of rain barrels to residents (“*Intergovernmental Agreement*”).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1: That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2: The Intergovernmental Agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, is hereby approved substantially in the form presented to this City Council, with such necessary changes as may be approved by the Mayor.

Section 3: The Mayor and City Clerk are hereby authorized and directed to execute and deliver the Intergovernmental Agreement and any and all other document necessary to implement the provisions, terms and conditions thereof, as therein described.

Section 4: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


Section 6: This Ordinance shall take effect immediately and be in force from and after its passage and approval due to the urgent nature of this matter.

ORDINANCE NO.: 14-42

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS**

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 90-317 (Handicapped parking) of Article V [Stopping, Standing and Parking] of Chapter 90 [Traffic and Vehicles] of the Municipal Code of Calumet City, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following language to subsection G (Signed areas) to read, as follows:

355 Chappel Avenue

Section 2. The Commissioner of Streets and Alleys is hereby authorized and directed to install the proper signs in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.




