- Section 2. That the 2013 CDBG Subrecipient Agreement, Project 1306-004, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit A, is hereby approved for Program Year 2013, in the amount of \$140,000.00 for Capital Improvements: Street Improvements.
- Section 3. That the Mayor is hereby authorized to submit the Subrecipient Agreement, all understanding and assurances and to execute the 2013 Community Development Block Grant Program Year Agreements with the County of Cook, Illinois for Project Number 1306-004.
- **Section 4**. That the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to execute any and all additional documents necessary to carry out the 2013 Community Development Block Grant Program for the City.
 - Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held

invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

Section 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section 1. That Section 90-317 (Handicapped parking) of Article V [Stopping, Standing and Parking] of Chapter 90 [Traffic and Vehicles] of the Municipal Code of Calumet City, Illinois, is hereby amended by deleting the following language in subsection G (Signed areas), as follows:

731 Sibley Boulevard

- **Section 2.** The Commissioner of Streets and Alleys is hereby authorized and directed to remove such signs in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.
- **Section 3**. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
 - Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
 - **Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
