Public Comment

#2: Discussion MFT update Motor Fuel Tax Fund update; move forward with 2015 Sidewalk and Concrete Program in the amount of \$155,260.00 which was approved on 8/13/15; contractor to begin work in April; lists to be submitted prior to April 1, 2016.

Alderman Munda entered meeting at 9:06 a.m.

Mayor Michelle Markiewicz Qualkinbush: "Apparently we are all caught up on our MFT allotments. We are ready to go forward. The Sidewalk 2015 Program, which was awarded but put on hold because of the MFT allotment not coming through.

The contractors are asking to schedule the work to begin in April so we will have to move rather quickly to our lists to the contractor for the 2015 Sidewalk Program. The contractor is anxious to get started."

Alderman Wosczynski: "Does he still have the list from last year?"

Mayor Michelle Markiewicz Qualkinbush: "I am sure he does. They want to get started when the weather breaks in the spring with last year's program."

Alderman Williams: "Is there a certain time that we have to do the MFT program by?"

Mayor Michelle Markiewicz Qualkinbush: "It is last year's program that was on hold. Like I said, the contractor has other areas too. What I don't want him to do is schedule us in December.

Do you have an issue with getting a list."

Alderman Williams: "My list is already in. I was just thinking progressively for the future that it may be better to do it around late summer."

Mayor Michelle Markiewicz Qualkinbush: "I will ask him. We are not the only town in the mix. But I will ask if it is possible to do it in August.

Likely if everything continues to go forward and the MFT remains solvent."

Alderman Wosczynski: "Maybe we can do two this year."

Mayor Michelle Markiewicz Qualkinbush: "Perhaps, but maybe not. I understand your concern and I will chat with him and see if we can get it pushed to August or September. We just don't want it to go to November or December."

City Treasurer Tarka: "The Sidewalk Program is awarded at the same time of the year. But I have seen the sidewalks be put in the spring and all the way up to December. It is partially contingent upon the contractor and what kind of jobs he has scheduled."

Mayor Michelle Markiewicz Qualkinbush: "My concern was, I wanted to get us early in the list, because we didn't do it last year. I thought everyone was a little anxious to get moving on the program.

I just wanted to report that to the city council."

# #4: Award bid/Sibley Blvd. Multi Use Trail

Award the bid for the Sibley Boulevard - Multi Use Trail Installation to Gallagher Asphalt Corporation in the amount of \$154,240.60; direct the City Treasurer to issue payment from the MFT Fund.

Mayor Michelle Markiewicz Qualkinbush: "On item #4, met with Finance Director Kasperek and Treasurer Tarka. We now have money coming in the MFT fund. I am hoping that the city council will award the bid for the Sibley Boulevard Multi Use Trail Installation.

That is the bike path that will connect west of Torrence to the bike path, which is east of Torrence. We bid that out last year and we table that item also waiting to see what the condition of the MFT fund was.
