RESOLUTION NUMBER 19-03

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY ILLINOIS SUPPORTING THE RENEWAL OF A CLASS 6B REAL ESTATE TAX ASSESSMENT CLASSIFICATION FOR 140 STATE STREET (B.C. HOLDINGS, LLC)

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois (the "City), is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "Home Rule Powers"); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook have enacted an ordinance known as the Cook County Real Property Assessment Classification Ordinance, as amended from time to time (the "Classification Ordinance"), which allows for various real estate tax assessment classifications as an incentive to encourage industrial and commercial growth within the County of Cook in order to create job opportunities and expand the tax base; and

WHEREAS, B.C. Holdings, LLC, Brian L. Essary as sole member of B.C. Holdings (the "Applicant"), is the owner of certain parcels of property within the City that are commonly known as 140 State Street, Calumet City, Illinois - and identified by permanent index numbers (PINs) 30-08-203-002-0000, 30-08-203-003-0000, 30-08-203-004-0000, 30-08-203-023-0000, 30-08-203-024-0000, 30-08-203-025-0000, 30-08-203-026-0000, and 30-08-203-027-0000, which are legally described in Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has requested that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City (the "Corporate Authorities") support and consent to the renewal of its Cook County Class 6B Real Estate Tax Assessment Classification for the Property, as said term is defined in the Classification Ordinance (the "Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification"), and as previously authorized by the Corporate Authorities October 23, 2008 as Resolution number 08-93, a copy of said authorizing document is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant is seeking a Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification Renewal in order to alleviate the financial constraints it will experience regarding the continued use of the property for the total business operation of Advance Products, Inc., an industrial leader in providing custom precision screw machine and powder metal components; and

WHEREAS, the Applicant has proposed its continued investment into the property and to retain its 5 full-time employees, the viability dependent on the eligibility of the Property for a Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification Renewal; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of a resolution by the Corporate Authorities is required and must be filed by Applicant with its renewal application with the County of Cook in order for the Property to maintain its Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities find that the sustainment of the industrial business on the Property will only occur if the renewal of the Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification is authorized so as to continue its operations as well as maintain its current staff and without such designation, the Applicant's business would not be economically viable causing the Property to be in imminent risk of becoming vacant and unused; and

WHEREAS, to help alleviate financial hardship, to promote industrial growth, to maintain employment opportunities within the City, and to continue to diversify the tax base of the City, the Corporate Authorities declare that it is necessary and in the best interests of the City to approve the renewal of the Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification for the Property, pursuant to the Classification Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities hereby request that the President and Cook County

Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook concur with the findings by the City and authorize the renewal of the Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification for the Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

Section 1: That the above recitals and legislative finds are found to be true and correct and are

hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2: The Corporate Authorities find that the financial hardship of the Applicant and Property necessitate the renewal of the Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification without which the Property will become vacant and underutilized causing the exasperation of blighted factors within the area surrounding the Property.

Section 3: The Corporate Authorities find that the renewal of the Class 6B Tax Assessment Classification incentive program established by the County of Cook is necessary for the existing development herein to continue on the Property, which is the subject of this Resolution.

Section 4: The Corporate Authorities support and consent to the filing of a renewal of Class 6B

Tax Assessment Incentive Eligibility Application by the Applicant for the Property, which is legally described on Exhibit A.

Section 5: If any section, paragraph, clause, or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity hereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

Section 6: All ordinances, resolutions, motions, or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7: This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A CLASS 6B TAX ASSESSMENT CLASSIFICATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A WAREHOUSE AND DISTRIBUTION FACILITY IN THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, ILLINOIS, COOK COUNTY

WHEREAS, the officers of Advance Products, Inc., have requested that the City Council grant approval for a Cook County Class 6B tax assessment classification related to the construction of an office and distribution facility within the City of Calumet City; and,

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City is a Home Rule municipality within the purview of Article VII, Section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution (1970), and the said City, therefore, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and,

WHEREAS, such approval is required prior to the filing by the property owner of an application with the County of Cook to be considered for such an assessment classification; and,

WHEREAS, a County ordinance allows for various real property assessment classifications as an incentive for manufacturing and distribution growth within the County thereby creating job opportunity and a stable tax base; and,

WHEREAS, in order to promote industrial and commercial growth and to promote the creation of new jobs within the City, the City Council of Calumet City has determined that it is in the best interests of the City to approve the Class 6B assessment classification for the proposed new development.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

ORDINANCE NO.: 19-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 90-317 (Handicapped parking) of Article V [Stopping, Standing and Parking] of Chapter 90 [Traffic and Vehicles] of the Municipal Code of Calumet City, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following language to subsection G (Signed areas) to read, as follows:

579 Wentworth

- Section 2. The Commissioner of Streets and Alleys is hereby authorized and directed to install the proper signs in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.
- Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.
- Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
- **Section 5.** This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
