A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY
ILLINOIS SUPPORTING THE RENEWAL OF A CLASS 8 REAL ESTATE TAX
ASSESSMENT CLASSIFICATION FOR THE PROPERTY LOCATED AT 525 WENTWORTH
(NURTURING DEVELOPMENT AND LEARNING ACADEMY CENTER)

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois (the "City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "Home Rule Powers"); and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Commissioners of the County of Cook have enacted an ordinance known as the Cook County Real Property Assessment Classification.

Ordinance, as amended from time to time (the "Classification Ordinance"), which provides for a tax assessment incentive classification designed to encourage development throughout Cook. County by offering a real estate tax incentive for the development of new facilities, the rehabilitation of existing structures and the utilization of abandoned buildings in order to create employment opportunities and expand the tax base; and

WHEREAS, Nurturing Development and Learning Academy/Center (the "Owner") owns a certain parcel of property within the City commonly known as 525 Wentworth, Calumet City, Illinois, identified by a certain permanent index number (PIN) 30-08-400-052-0000 and hereinafter legally described on Exhibit A, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Owner has requested that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City (the "Corporate Authorities") support and consent to the renewal of its Cook

County Class 8 Real Estate Tax Assessment Classification for the Property, as said term is defined in the Classification Ordinance (the "Class 8 Tax Assessment Classification"), and as previously authorized by the Corporate Authorities on June 14, 2007 by Resolution No. 07-46 a copy of said authorizing document is attached hereto and made a part hereof, as Exhibit B; and

WHEREAS, the adoption of a resolution by the Corporate Authorities is required and must be filed by Owner with its renewal application with the County of Cook in order for the Property to maintain its Class 8 Tax Assessment Classification; and

WHEREAS, Owner is an important entity in the City operating a center for child care services and education, employing 20 full time and 5 part-time employees and whose economic viability is dependent on the continued Class 8 Tax Assessment Classification; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the ongoing viability of the facility, the continuation of numerous employment positions in the City and to safeguard the tax base of the City, the Corporate Authorities have determined that it is necessary and in the best interests of the City to approve the renewal of the Class 8 Real Estate Tax Assessment Classification for the Property.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

Section 1. That the above recitals and legislative findings are found to be true and correct and are hereby incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as if fully set forth in their entirety.

Section 2. The Corporate Authorities find that the continuing economic viability of the Property is necessary and appropriate for the community and that without a Class 8 Tax Assessment Classification the Property would be underutilized and cause blight in the area surrounding the Property.

Section 3. The Corporate Authorities find that the Class 8 Tax Assessment Classification incentive program established by the County of Cook is necessary for the ongoing use and habitability of the Property, which is the subject of this Resolution.

Section 4. The Corporate Authorities support and consent to the filing of a Class 8 Tax Incentive Eligibility Renewal Application by the Applicant and Owner of the Property, which is legally described on Exhibit A.

Section 5. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Resolution shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Resolution.

Section 6. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Resolution are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City (the "City") is an Illinois municipal corporation under the laws of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, Nurturing Developmental Learning Academy, through its officers, has requested the City Council for the CITY OF CALUMET CITY to support its application for a Cook County Class 8 Tax Assessment Classification for construction of a commercial facility located at 525 Wentworth Avenue, Calumet City, Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City is a Home Rule municipality within the purview of Article VII, section 6(a) of the Illinois Constitution (1970), and the said City, therefore, may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, such city approval is required prior to the filing by the property owner of an application with the County of Cook to be considered for extension of such an assessment classification; and

WHEREAS, the County of Cook has adopted ordinances for various real property assessment classifications as an incentive for commercial growth within the County; and

WHEREAS, the subject property is located in Thornton Township, which is a part of the South Suburban Tax Reactivation Pilot Program; and

WHEREAS, in order to promote commercial growth and to promote the creation of new jobs within the city, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City have determined it is in the best interest of the City to approve the class 8 assessment classification for the proposed development.

ORDINANCE NO.: 19-01

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. That Section 90-317 (Handicapped parking) of Article V [Stopping, Standing and Parking] of Chapter 90 [Traffic and Vehicles] of the Municipal Code of Calumet City, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following language to subsection G (Signed areas) to read, as follows:

646 Mackinaw

Section 2. The Commissioner of Streets and Alleys is hereby authorized and directed to install the proper signs in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NUMBER: 19-02

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS TO OBTAIN AN EXTENSION OF A \$1,200,000 REVOLVING LOAN MADE BY MB FINANCIAL BANK, N.A. AND AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF MISCELLANEOUS LOAN DOCUMENTS THEREFOR

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois (the "City"), pursuant to the provisions of Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, is a home rule unit of local government and is authorized to exercise any power or perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs including, but not limited to, the power to tax and to incur indebtedness without referendum; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain an extension of an ex1stmg \$1,200,000.00 revolving line of credit loan made by MB Financial Bank, N.A. (the "Bank") to the City for working capital purposes from February 22, 2019 until June 30, 2019 (the "Revolving Loan Extension"); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is advisable, necessary and in the best interests of the City to secure the Revolving Loan (as being extended) and that repayments on the Revolving Loan (as being extended) should be secured by the City's general obligation pledge; and

WHEREAS, the final forms of documents reflecting the Revolving Loan Extension have been prepared and are on file with the City; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, in the exercise of its home rule powers as follows:

Section 1. Recitals.

The foregoing recitals are true, correct and material to this Ordinance and shall be incorporated herein as if they were fully set forth in this Section.

Section 2. Approval of Revolving Loan Extension.

The City approves the Revolving Loan Extension with a maturity date of June 30, 2019 under terms and provisions set forth in the Loan Agreement and Revolving Note, as modified by the Loan Modification Agreement, each attached as **Exhibit A**. The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute such Loan Modification Agreement and such other agreements, amendments, certificates or instruments (collectively, the "Loan Documents") as may be necessary to obtain the Revolving Loan Extension, with such changes as may be made to such Loan Documents between the date of this Ordinance and the date of execution as may be approved by the City and the City Attorney, such approval to be evidenced by the execution of the Loan Documents by the Mayor and the City Clerk.

Section 3. General Obligation.

The repayment obligations of the City under the Revolving Loan (as being extended) shall be a general obligation of the City, for which the full faith and credit of the City are hereby irrevocably pledged and are payable from all sources available to the City to make such repayment including, without limitation, from the levy of taxes on all of the taxable property in the City, without limitation as to rate or amount. For the prompt payment of the Revolving Loan (as being extended), both principal and interest, at maturity, the full faith, credit and resources of the City are hereby irrevocably pledged.

Section 4. Approval and execution of other required instruments.

The Mayor and the City Clerk are hereby authorized to execute such other instruments, documents, certificates or agreements reasonably required by MB Financial Bank, N.A. in order to effectuate the consummation of the Revolving Loan Extension and the delivery of the Loan Documents and such other documents required to be executed in connection with the Revolving Loan Extension, the approval of such documents to be subject to the review and approval of counsel to the City, such approval to be evidenced by the execution of any such other instruments, certificates or agreements by the Mayor and the City Clerk of the City.

Section 5. Home Rule.

This Ordinance, and each of its terms, shall be the effective legislative act of the City in accordance with the powers as a home rule unit under Article VII of the 1970 Illinois Constitution without regard to whether such Ordinance should: (a) contain terms contrary to the provisions of current or subsequent non-preemptive state law; or (b) legislate in a manner or regarding a matter not delegated to municipalities by state law. It is the intent of the City Council of the City of Calumet City that to the extent that the terms of this Ordinance should be inconsistent with any non-preemptive state law, this Ordinance shall supersede state law in that regard within its jurisdiction.

Section 6. Invalidity.

In the event any portion of this ordinance is found to be invalid, the remaining portions of this ordinance shall be severable from any such invalid portion and enforced to the fullest extent possible.

Section 7. Repealer.

The specific terms and conditions of this Ordinance shall prevail against other existing ordinances of the City to the extent there may be any conflict. All existing ordinances of the City which directly conflict with the terms of this Ordinance are herein repealed.

Section 8. Effective date.

This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.

LOAN MODIFICATION AGREEMENT

THIS LOAN MODIFICATION AGREEMENT (this "Agreement") dated as of January 10, 2019 is between CITY OF CALUMET CITY, an Illinois home unit and municipal corporation (the "Borrower"), with its chief executive office at 204 Pulaski Road, Calumet City, Illinois 60409, and MB FINANCIAL BANK, N. A., a national banking association (the "Bank").

WHEREAS, Borrower and Bank have entered in that certain Loan Agreement dated as of February 23, 2018 (the "Loan Agreement") with regard to a certain \$1,200,000.00 revolving line of credit loan (the "Revolving Loan") made by the Bank to the Borrower and evidenced by that certain Revolving Note dated February 23, 2018 in the principal amount of \$1,200,000.00 executed by Borrower and payable to the order of the Bank on February 22, 2019 together with interest payable monthly as therein described (the "Revolving Note"); and

WHEREAS, Borrower has asked the Bank to extend the maturity date of the Revolving Loan from February 22, 2019 until June 30, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Bank has consented to such loan request provided, among other conditions, that Borrower executes and delivers to the Bank this Agreement and such other documents and instruments required by the Bank in connection with said loan extension.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the foregoing, and for valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which are hereby acknowledged, the parties agree as follows:

- 1. All capitalized terms used herein and not defined shall have the meaning set forth in the Loan Agreement, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference.
- 2. Borrower and Bank agree that the Revolving Note is hereby amended as follows:
- a. In the first line of the first paragraph on page 1 of the Revolving Note, the words "On February 22, 2019 (the "Maturity Date")" are hereby deleted, and the words "On June 30, 2019 (the "Maturity Date")" are substituted therefor. Accordingly, Borrower acknowledges and agrees that the Revolving Note, as modified, shall be due and payable in full on June 30, 2019.
- b. In the fourth paragraph on page 1 of the Revolving Note, the date "February 15, 2019" appearing in the third line is hereby deleted, and the date "June 15, 2019" is substituted therefor.
- 3. Borrower and Bank agree that the Loan Agreement is hereby amended as follows:

a. The first sentence of the first paragraph of Section 2.3 of the Loan Agreement is hereby amended in its entirety to read as follows:

The Revolving Loan shall be evidenced by a Revolving Note dated February 23, 2018 in the principal amount of One Million Two Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,200,000.00) executed by the Borrower, as modified by Loan Modification Agreement dated as of January ____, 2019 between Borrower and the Bank, and payable to the order of the Bank on June 30, 2019 (such note and any and all extensions, renewals, amendments, refinancings, modifications, conversions or consolidations thereof or thereto, the "Revolving Note").

Hereafter, all references in the Loan Agreement, this Agreement and all other Loan Documents to the term "Revolving Note" shall be deemed to refer to the Revolving Note dated February 23, 2018 in the principal amount of One Million Two Hundred Thousand and 00/100 Dollars (\$1,200,000.00) executed by the Borrower, as modified by Loan Modification Agreement dated as of January 10, 2019 between Borrower and the Bank, and payable to the order of the Bank on June 30, 2019, together with interest payable monthly as therein described.

- 4. The Borrower acknowledges and agrees that the Revolving Note and Loan Agreement are and as amended hereby shall remain in full force and effect.
- 5. Without limiting the foregoing, the Borrower hereby agrees that, notwithstanding the execution and delivery hereof, (i) all rights and remedies of the Bank under the Revolving Note, the Loan Agreement and the other Loan Documents, and (ii) all obligations and indebtedness of the Borrower thereunder, shall remain in full force and effect, and this Agreement shall constitute and be an acknowledgment and continuation of the rights and remedies in favor of the Bank, and the obligations and indebtedness of the Borrower to the Bank, which exist under the Revolving Note, the Loan Agreement and all other Loan Documents, as amended hereby.
- 6. In order to induce Bank to enter into this Agreement, the Borrower hereby represents and warrants to the Bank that as of the date hereto, each of the representations and warranties set forth in the Loan Agreement, as amended hereby, are true and correct and the Borrower is in full compliance with all of the terms and conditions of the Loan Agreement, as amended hereby, and no Event of Default or Default has occurred and is continuing.
- 7. Except as specifically amended and modified hereby, all of the terms and conditions of the Revolving Note, the Loan Agreement and all other Loan Documents shall stand and remain unchanged and in full force and effect. This Agreement shall be construed and governed by and in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois (excluding choice of law principles). This Agreement hereby incorporates all of the terms and conditions of the Revolving Note and Loan Agreement, except to the extent modified by this Agreement.
