ORDINANCE NO. 18-34

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 90, ARTICLE VIII, SECTION 90-584, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES)

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois (the "City") is a home rule municipality pursuant to Section 6(a), Article VII of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois, and as such may exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs (the "Home Rule Powers"); and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and the City Council of the City of Calumet City (the "Corporate Authorities") may from time to time amend the text of the Municipal Code of Calumet City when it is determined to be in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities are charged with the responsibility of overseeing implementation of the terms and provisions of the City's Motor Vehicle License Ordinance, including regulating and assessing the fees charged to residents who have served in the Armed Forces of the United States of America, have been honorably discharged from the branch of the Armed Forces in which they served, and by virtue of their honorable service are entitled to consideration for their dedication to our country.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its Home Rule Powers, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals are incorporated herein and made a part hereof, as it fully set forth in their entirety.

SECTION 2: That Chapter 90 ("Traffic and Vehicles"), Article VIII ("Vehicle Licenses"), Section 90-584, ("Fee"), of the Municipal Code of Calumet City, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the underlined language as follows:

(e) Any person who was in the Armed Forces of the United States of America, was honorably discharged, and has been issued a DD-214 Form verifying their status as an honorably discharged veteran, shall be entitled to a \$25.00 discount to be subtracted from the license fee charged for any passenger vehicle, motor scooter, motor tricycle, or motor bicycle vehicle. The \$25.00 discount will be allowed for only one (1) such vehicle license to be issued to said person.

SECTION 3: If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any of the other provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4: All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

SECTION 5: This ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

Section 1. That Section 90-317 (Handicapped parking) of Article V [Stopping, Standing and Parking] of Chapter 90 [Traffic and Vehicles] of the Municipal Code of Calumet City, Illinois, is hereby amended by adding the following language to subsection G (Signed areas) to read, as follows:

212 Mason

Section 2. The Commissioner of Streets and Alleys is hereby authorized and directed to install the proper signs in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Ordinance.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

ORDINANCE NO. 18-35

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE PREVAILING WAGE STANDARDS IN THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS

WHEREAS, the State of Illinois (the "State") has enacted the "Prevailing Wage Act," 820 ILCS 130/1 et seq. (the "Act") which is an act regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the State that a wage of no less than the general prevailing hourly rate as paid for work of a similar character in the locality in which the work is performed, shall be paid to all laborers, mechanics and other workers employed by or on behalf of any and all public bodies engaged in public works; and

WHEREAS, the Act requires that the City of Calumet City investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in the Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of the City of Calumet City employed in performing construction of public works, for the City of Calumet City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City has ascertained and examined the prevailing wage classifications and rates determined by the Department of Labor for Cook County for September 2017, which is the last available date wage rates were published by the Department of Labor.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1: That the above recitals and legislative findings are incorporated herein and made a part hereof.

SECTION 2: To the extent and as required by the Act, the general prevailing rates of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of the City of Calumet City is hereby ascertained to be the

same as the prevailing rates of wages for construction work in the Cook County area, as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois as of September 1, 2017. (See Exhibit "A").

SECTION 3: As required by the Act, any and all revisions of the prevailing rates of wages by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois shall supersede the Department's last publication of prevailing rates for construction work undertaken by the City of Calumet City. The definition of any terms appearing in the Ordinance which are also used in the Act shall be the same as in the Act.

SECTION 4: Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction undertaken by the City of Calumet City to the extent required by the Act.

SECTION 5: The City Clerk shall publicly post this determination or any revisions of such prevailing rate of wages, and keep it available for inspection at the Village Hall by any interested party. A copy of the determination or of the currently revised determination of the prevailing rate of wages then in effect shall be attached to all contract specifications.

SECTION 6: The City Clerk shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed their names and addresses, and have requested copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

SECTION 7: The City Clerk shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Illinois Department of Labor, Prevailing Wage Division, One West Old State Capitol Plaza, Room 300, Springfield, IL 62701.

SECTION 8: Within thirty (30) days after the filing with the Department of Labor, the City Clerk shall cause a notice to be published in a newspaper of general circulation within the City stating:

PUBLIC NOTICE OF ADOPTION OF PREVAILING WAGE STANDARDS

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that on July 12, 2018, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, adopted Ordinance No. 18-34 determining prevailing wages, as of the last available date wages were published by the State of Illinois Department of Labor pursuant to 820 ILCS 130/1 et seq., which determination is now effective.
