RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY FOR COMPLIANCE WITH THE ILLINOIS TRUTH IN TAXATION ACT FOR THE 2019 TAX LEVY COLLECTED IN 2020 RELATING TO THE CORPORATE FUND, THE LIBRARY FUND, THE IMRF PENSION FUND, THE POLICE AND FIRE PENSION FUNDS AND THE DEBT SERVICE FUNDS.

WHEREAS, Section 35 ILCS 200/18-60 provides that the City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois shall determine the amounts of money, exclusive of election costs, estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation for the tax year 2019 collected in 2020 upon the taxable property of the City of Calumet City; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to 35 ILCS 200/18-60, the City Council of the City of Calumet City on June 13, 2019 approved and authorized the public display of a City of Calumet City Corporate Fund, a City of Calumet City Library Fund, a City of Calumet City IMRF Pension Fund, and a City of Calumet City Police and Fire Pension Funds Budget prepared in tentative form for said City for the fiscal year beginning May 1, 2019 and ending April 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the budgets for said City of Calumet City Corporate Fund, City of Calumet City Library Fund, City of Calumet City IMRF Pension Fund, and City of Calumet City Police and Fire Pension Funds (hereinafter referred to as the Corporate & Special Purpose Funds) were adopted by the City Council of the City of Calumet City at a legal meeting held on the 11th day of July, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City has Debt Service Funds created for the payment of outstanding general obligation bonds and notes; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with said budgets and general obligation bond and note ordinances, the following amounts of money, in the aggregate, are estimated to be necessary to be raised by taxation for the 2019 tax year upon the taxable property of the City of Calumet City;

Ordinance No. _19-59__

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF CALUMET CITY, COOK COUNTY, ILLINOIS, DISSOLVING THE "INDUSTRIAL PARK REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA (TIF 2)" SPECIAL TAX ALLOCATION FUND AND TERMINATING THE DESIGNATION OF THE INDUSTRIAL PARK REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA (TIF 2)

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois (the "City"), is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State, and as a home rule unit may, under the powers granted by Section 6(a) of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970, "exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs"; and,

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Tax Increment Allocation Redevelopment Act of the State of Illinois, 65 ILCS 5/11-74.4-1 et seq., as from time to time amended (the "TIF Act"), the Mayor and City Council of the City (the "Corporate Authorities") are empowered to undertake the development or redevelopment of a designated area within the municipal boundaries of the City in which existing conditions permit such area to be classified as a "blighted area" as defined in Section 11.74.4-3(a) of the TIF Act; and,

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities, pursuant to Ordinance No. 96-6, passed on January 25, 1996, did heretofore approve a redevelopment plan and redevelopment project, and pursuant to Ordinance No. 96-7, passed on January 25, 1996, designated a "redevelopment project area" known as the "Industrial Park Redevelopment Project Area" (the "Project Area"), and pursuant to Ordinance No. 96-8, passed on January 25, 1996, adopted tax increment allocation financing for the Project Area; and, in connection therewith, established the

"Industrial Park Redevelopment Project Area (TIF 2)" special tax allocation fund (the "Special Tax Allocation Fund"), all in accordance with the TIF Act; and,

WHEREAS, the Corporate Authorities have heretofore and hereby expressly determine that it is desirable and in the best interests of the City and the Taxing Districts that the Special Tax Allocation Fund be dissolved and the Project Area, as legally described on *Exhibit A* and depicted on *Exhibit B* attached hereto, be terminated; and,

WHEREAS, in accordance with the TIF Act, the City shall notify the Taxing Districts that the Project Area is to be terminated by December 31, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and City Council of the City of Calumet City, Cook County, Illinois, by and through its home rule powers, as follows:

Section 1. The Incorporation of Preambles. The Corporate Authorities hereby find that all of the recitals contained in the preambles to this Ordinance are true and correct and do hereby incorporate them into this Ordinance by this reference.

Section 2. Special Tax Allocation Fund Dissolved. The "Industrial Park Redevelopment Project Area (TIF 2)" Special Tax Allocation Fund is hereby dissolved.

Section 3. Designation of Project Area Terminated. As of December 31, 2019, the designation of the Industrial Park Redevelopment Project Area (TIF 2) shall be deemed to be terminated.

Section 4. Notice. That the City Clerk shall notify the Taxing Districts that the Project Area is to be terminated by December 31, 2019.

Section 5. Repealer. All ordinances, resolutions, orders or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 6. Effective Date. That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval, as provided by law.

LEGAL DESCRIPTION

The boundaries of the Project Area have been carefully drawn to include only those contiguous parcels of real property and improvements substantially benefitted by the proposed Redevelopment Program to be undertaken by the City as part of this Redevelopment Plan. The boundaries are legally described as follows:

Those parts of Sections 6 and 7, Township 36 North, Range 15 East of the Third Principal Meridian bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the Southwest corner of the East 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of said Section 6 and running thence North on the West line thereof to the Northeasterly line of a parcel of land designated in tax record as No. 30-06-400-031: thence Southeasterly along said Northeasterly line to the Westerly line of a parcel of land designated in tax record as No. 30-06-400-032; thence Northeasterly along said Westerly line to the North line of the last described parcel; thence East along said North line and the prolongation thereof to the center line of the grand Calumet River; thence Southeasterly along said center line to the East line of the Southeast 14 of the aforesaid Section 6; thence South along said East line and along the East line of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 7 to the Easterly prolongation of the South line of Stewart Avenue; thence West on the last described line and the prolongation thereof to the East line of Superior Avenue; thence South or the last described line and the prolongation thereof to the South line of Sibley Elvd., thence West on the last described line to the Southerly prolongation of the West line of Commercial Avenue; thence North on the last described line and the extension thereof to the Southeast corner of a parcel of land designated in tax record as No. 30-07-200-002; thence North and Northeasterly along the Easterly line of the last described parcel to the North line of the Northeast 1/4 of said Section 7; thence East on said North line to the point of beginning, all in Cook County, Illinois.

The location is commonly described as the area bounded by:

State Street and the Grand Calumet River on the North; Burnham Avenue and Superior Avenue on the East; Sibley Boulevard and Stewart Avenue on the South; and, the Commonwealth Utility Easement and Commercial Avenue on the West.

Section 3. If any section, paragraph, clause or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid, the invalidity thereof shall not affect any other provision of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.

- **Section 4.** All ordinances, resolutions, motions or orders in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.
