WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Calumet City, Illinois has taken action to submit a Rebuild Illinois competitive public infrastructure application,

WHEREAS, receipt of Rebuild Illinois grant assistance is essential to allow the City of Calumet City to undertake the project to develop Riverwalk Park and Canoe Launch on over 7 acres of City-Owned property,

WHEREAS, criteria are such that financial participation by the grantee is required in conjunction with Rebuild Illinois funds, and

WHEREAS, the City of Calumet City has certain monies allocated for the above-referenced project with cash on hand, as needed.


